PRELIMINARY STEPS

Before applying, ensure you meet the following requirements:

1. **Check your Admission Score with the Registrar Office:** You are eligible only if you are admitted during the first or second session (**March or May 2026**) with a minimum score of **80/100**.
 2. **Complete Admission First:** You must complete the entire university admission process *before* applying for the scholarship. We strongly recommend submitting your application well in advance of the deadline.

STEP 1: Gather and Submit Your Application

As a citizen of a particularly poor country, you must email the following documents to segreteria@unisg.it:

- **Official Financial Assessment:** A certificate issued by an Italian authority in your home country (Consulate or Embassy) and translated into Italian. The document must certify that:
 - You are a legal resident of that country.
 - You do not belong to a family known to have high income or high social status.
- **Application Form:** The completed scholarship application form (**Attachment 4**).



Email Instructions:

- **Subject Line:** "Scholarship application, a.y. 2026/2027 – [Name of your Program]"
- **Format:** Documents must be clear, readable, and sent in PDF or Word format.
- **Deadline:** Your digital application must be received by the date indicated in the official scholarship announcement.

Note: The University reserves the right to request additional documentation to verify the accuracy of your submission.

STEP 2: Results and Ranking

The final list of scholarship recipients will be published on the University website (www.unisg.it) on the date specified in the announcement.

Stateless or Refugee Students

You only need to provide an official statement issued by the **Italian Ministry of the Interior** or the **UNHCR**.
